Assuming a population of 200,000 people and owner occupied units of about 60,000, a very small percentage of this market will be able to purchase an ownership share. Just on the basis of owner occupied housing units, only 1.7% of these owners will be allowed to purchase a share. I believe the competition for these ownership units will be brisk, so do not delay in signing up and getting in line to buy a share as soon as you hear about this opportunity.

Please keep in mind that the purchase of an ownership share includes everyone in your family, husband, wife and all children under 21 years old. I recommend all single family home owners, townhome owners and condo owners buy an ownership share. You can effectively assign the ownership of these "river rights" as part of your residence. If in the future you sell your home, these "river rights" can be passed on to the new owner and a greater purchase price should be realized. It would not surprise me, that in 5 years, when all sales of these ownership shares have stopped, the only shares that would become available, would be private sales of these shares at prices determined by the seller. Who knows what premium the market will place upon the value of these shares? \$5,000, \$10,000, \$15,000? No one can predict at this time, but the value will be at a premium, I expect.
